The Board of Directors and the planning committee look forward to building off what the conference has been and what we will build it to be with Bismarck State College.

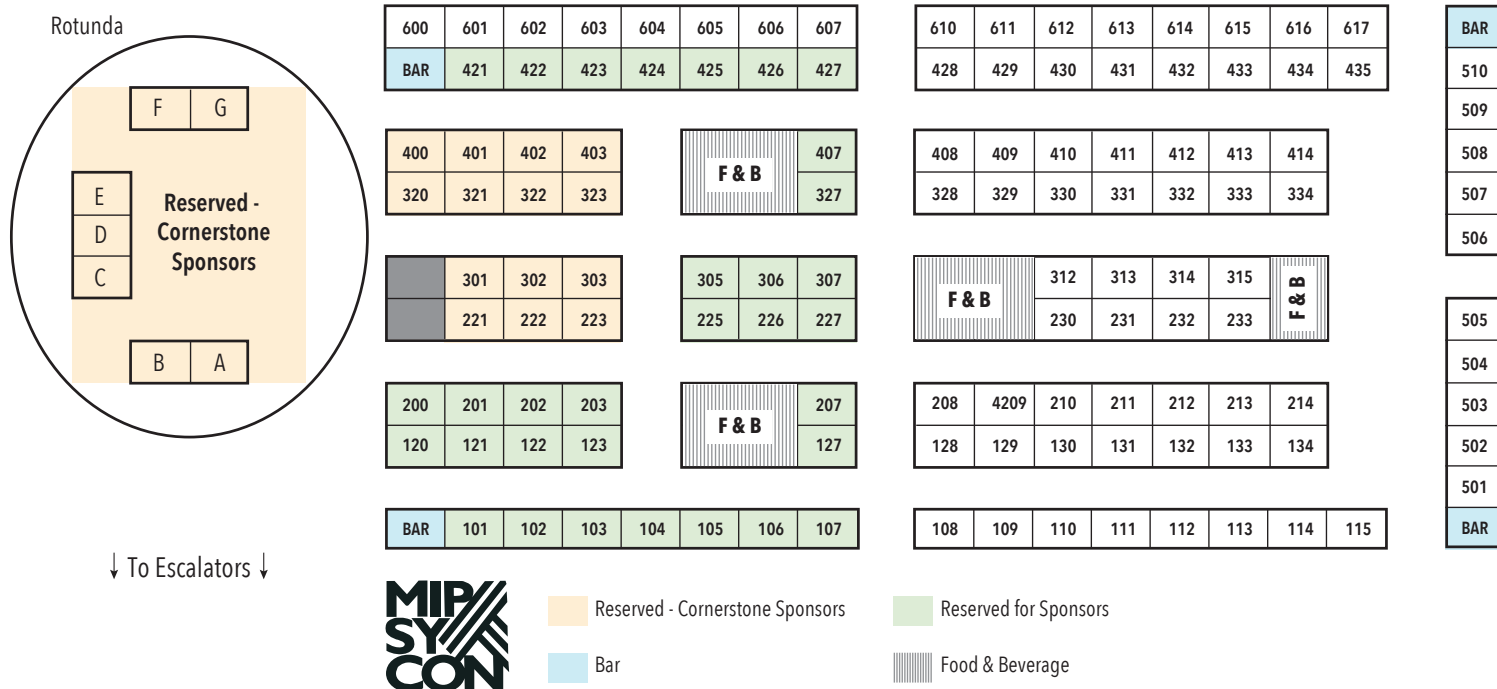
