What is Blackboard?

Blackboard is a Learning Management System (LMS) designed to allow students and faculty to participate in classes delivered online or use online materials and activities to complement a face-to-face class.

You can find the following in Blackboard:

- Announcements
- Course documents/Syllabi
- Assignments, quizzes, and tests
- Grades
- Discussions and Journals

Where Do I Find Blackboard?

- Go to the BSC homepage (bismarckstate.edu) and click the “**Logins**” menu, then “Blackboard”.

How do I log in?

- Click “My Bb Login”. Blackboard Username and Password are the same as your CampusConnection login (a.k.a your NDUS Credentials).
@bismarckstate.edu or @ndus.edu is not required



When Do I Receive Access?

You usually have access to log into Blackboard within 48 hours after you register for courses in Campus Connection. After registering for courses, you should see your next semester courses, but you will generally not be able to access the courses until the first day of class. If you enroll in a course after the course has begun, it should appear in Blackboard within 24 hours.

Tips

- BSC/NDUS email is the official means of communication. Your instructor will use this email address to communicate with you throughout the class.
- Instructors cannot reply to your gmail, iCloud, Yahoo, etc. email addresses.
