POSITION SUMMARY:

JET Apprentice: Will assist with the operation of various natural gas processing equipment at the Tioga Gas Plant. The apprentice will be required to perform minor maintenance and equipment repairs and enter daily production information into computer system with help from mentor/coach. This position will vary in length based on students' academic standing. Must be willing to work hours that reflect business needs; including 12 hour rotating shift work.

ROLES/RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Assist with operating changes necessary for safe and efficient gas plant operations.
- Relay operating/safety problems or concerns to supervisor.
- Work with Reliability Operator to perform equipment surveillance, autonomous maintenance, and first-level response with direct supervisor.
- Work with Reliability Operator to operate equipment and understand process controls & flow with direct supervision.
- Perform minor repairs on failed operating equipment with direct supervision.
- Complies with all Hess Rules and guidance (energy isolation, confined space, hot work).
- Complies with Process Safety Management (PSM) regulations, knowledgeable on how work needs to be conducted to meet regulatory compliance.
- Adhere to written operating procedures for shutdown and startup of equipment.
- Adhere to lockout/tagout procedures to prepare equipment for maintenance work.
- Actively participate in Job Safety Analysis (JSAs) and monthly safety meetings.
- Participate in emergency response activities as required by mentor.
- Participate in Process Hazard Analysis (PHA) and Pre-Startup Safety Reviews (PSSR) as required.
- Perform daily Spill Prevention Control and Countermeasures (SPCC) and Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plans (SWPPP) inspections and document results with direct supervision.

EXPERIENCE:

- Willing to accept responsibility and accountability with a positive attitude.
- Good communication skills, both verbal and written.
- Good knowledge of safety/environmental requirements and practices.
- Must be physically able to climb stairs, operator valves and pumps and perform maintenance work under air supplied breathing equipment.
- Must be willing to work weekends and holidays according to the normal operating schedule.
- Proven safety experience/training regarding oil and gas operations including but not limited to, confined space, LO/TO, H₂S, personal protective equipment, etc.
- Must have valid driver's license.
