

MEDICAL LAB SCIENTIST

TRANSFER

A medical laboratory scientist (MLS) has extensive knowledge of laboratory tests and data and performs complex tests and analysis. Besides lab work, a MLS is qualified to supervise a clinical laboratory, specialize in specific areas or go into clinical education. Becoming a registered MLS requires three years of academic studies and one year of professional training in a healthcare setting. BSC offers the first years of coursework required for a Bachelor of Science in medical laboratory science.

PREPARATION AND REQUIREMENTS

Students should have an interest and aptitude in science, math and critical thinking, be skilled at detail work and have good communication skills. This is a demanding program that requires discipline, self-motivation and ability to work independently. A strong science background with high school

classes in chemistry, biology and algebra is recommended. Students must contact the transfer school early and apply to an accredited medical laboratory science program second semester of sophomore year.
