Religion is an inter-disciplinary field with a foundation in the humanities. Study of religion helps develop skills in critical thinking, analytical writing, public speaking, and cross-cultural communication. BSC offers the first two years of coursework toward a baccalaureate degree in a religious studies specialty. Instruction is designed to provide a base of general education and social science classes, along with introductory courses in religion. Study includes world religions, philosophy, ethics, the biblical Old and New Testament and religion in America. Students who complete the requirements earn an Associate in Arts degree.

Those pursuing a religion major should be interested in history and the study of ideas through time. The need for clear expression requires good communication skills. Background in

the social sciences is helpful. An advanced degree will provide the best job opportunities.
