Report of Program Activity Since October 2017 Meeting

MLT Class of 2018

Sanford: Student #1 failed microbiology course summer 2017; would repeat in summer 2018, then complete micro. rotation. Allowed to continue with other curriculum and rotations. Failed mycology and BB rotation practical exam end of fall semester - dismissed. Student #2 completed program, then failed both comp exam A and B. Dismissed.

NPL: Two students complete program & graduate in few weeks, scheduled to write BOC. Both have job offers at NPL.

HR: One student finishing incomplete in BB course and will start clinicals this summer.

MLT Class of 2019

Started Fall 2017 with 9 students at BSC and 4 students at MCC. Picked up 2 more students at MCC spring semester. Now 5 at BSC and 4 at MCC, although 1 at each campus plans to return this fall. NPL elected to take a year off from students, so all 5 in Bismarck will be at Sanford. One in MT at Holy Rosary in Miles City, 1 in Lewistown (see below), 1 in Sidney, 1 in Billings.

Potentially starting this fall: Bismarck - 9 Miles City - 6 or 7
