This ESL class is for English learners with strong language skills who want to improve their fluency and accuracy. This course is intended for students who have achieved level 6 English proficiency. Using the Future Advanced textbook and workbook, this course focuses on advanced grammar, vocabulary, and communication skills. Students will enhance their fluency in speaking, listening, reading, and writing through exercises, group discussions, and real-world scenarios. This class provides a challenging and supportive environment for students to further develop their English language proficiency and prepare for academic or professional success.

Student Requirements

Class admission requirements include:

- Students must demonstrate English language proficiency at level 6.
- A 6-week commitment.
- Class is Tuesdays & Wednesdays from 1:30 PM to 3:00 PM.
- Any student missing more than two days or three hours of class time will be dropped out of the class, regardless of the reason.

Classes do not need to be taken in order.

Students can register for Part 2 before taking Part 1.
