



916.4 – Law Enforcement Authority

Purpose:

The purpose of this procedure is to operationalize BSC Policy 916.4 Law Enforcement Authority.

Procedure:

1. BSC Campus Police maintain a secure and accessible campus for students, employees, contractors, visitors, and guests.
2. BSC's Campus Police personnel have a responsibility to safeguard the college community and protect the proprietary interest of BSC.
3. All criminal offenses such as sexual offenses, aggravated assault, robbery, and auto theft are reported to BSC Campus Police.
4. When appropriate, joint investigative efforts with investigators from BSC Campus Police and local law enforcement are deployed for resolution.
