

441.2 - President's Honor Roll

Purpose:

The purpose of this Operational Procedure is to establish procedures for the President to recognize students for academic achievement.

Procedure:

1. Students who have earned a 3.50 institutional grade point average while enrolled in 12 or more semester hours of Bismarck State College coursework with honor points for the semester/session.
2. President's Honor Roll is noted on the student's transcript at the end of each semester/session.
3. Students may not be listed if they have requested FERPA privacy suppression which restricts the student's academic information from being released.
4. A change of a final grade which impacts academic honors, will be updated on the student's transcript.
