

## 916.7 - Timely Warnings

### **Purpose:**

This policy fulfills the [34 CFR § 668.46\(b\)\(2\)\(i\)](#) requirement necessitating a statement of policies concerning making timely warning reports to members of the campus community.

### **Policy:**

Bismarck State College will issue a timely warning when it receives a report of a crime that represents a serious or ongoing threat to the safety of members of the campus community. BSC may also issue a warning to the campus community when other instances pose a safety concern.
