

Student Policy - Application Fee Waiver-Active Duty Military

Policy:

In accordance with the provisions of State Board of Higher Education Policy 805.3, Bismarck State College will waive the student application fee for all active duty military personnel, beginning March 1, 2009.

Definition:

For purposes of this policy, 'military personnel' is defined as an individual serving in any branch of the U.S. Military (Navy, Air Force, Marines, Army and Coast Guard), the National Guard or the Reserves.

To be eligible for the waiver, a student must provide proof of active duty status, with one of the following documents:

- Control Access Card (CAC) – copy of front side
- Military ID indicating active duty status
- Military orders indicating active duty status
- Most recent copy of Military Leave and Earning Statement (LES)

Document requirement may be waived if student enrollment information is provided by the military, such as through an online military education portal.
