TOOL ORDERING FAQ

When do I need my tools in the classroom?

Camera must be purchased and, in the classroom, the first day of class – **second semester**. (January)

Where do I purchase my tools?

Students may use their own camera, source their camera from a vendor of their choice. BSC does not sell tools for the Graphic Design and Communications program.

When do I purchase my Tools?

Depending on where you order/purchase your camera there may be a lag time, students are encouraged to order/purchase their camera early.

Can I use Financial Aid to pay for my tools?

All tuition and fees will be paid first; excess aid can be used for your camera purchase and is typically disbursed the third week of the semester.
