The Technical Studies program addresses a recognized need for business and industry to attract highly trained workers with a variety of skills and to retain current workers. This custom-designed program is intended for employed persons, who want to combine elements of two to three disciplines in a meaningful and logical sequence to meet their career goals. The program includes a minimum of 60 semester hours, of which at least 40 credits derive from two or more technical programs. Students who completed the curriculum requirements earn an Associate in Applied Science degree.

PREPARATION AND REQUIREMENTS

Incoming or potential students should be able to articulate their career goals clearly. Students work with an advisor to identify career goals and to plan a program of study.

CAREERS

- Technical Studies provides opportunities for career advancement, increased job responsibility or preparation for alternative employment.

Students identify one technical program as the primary focus, and one or more secondary focus areas that collectively contribute to the overall program.
