Students interested in becoming a Veterinarian can attend BSC for their first two years. Although Pre-Veterinary is not a degree, students will complete core requirements to be accepted into a Veterinary program. By following the curriculum plan an Associate in Science degree will be achieved. Since there are no Pre-Veterinary degrees, students are encouraged to identify a desired major.
