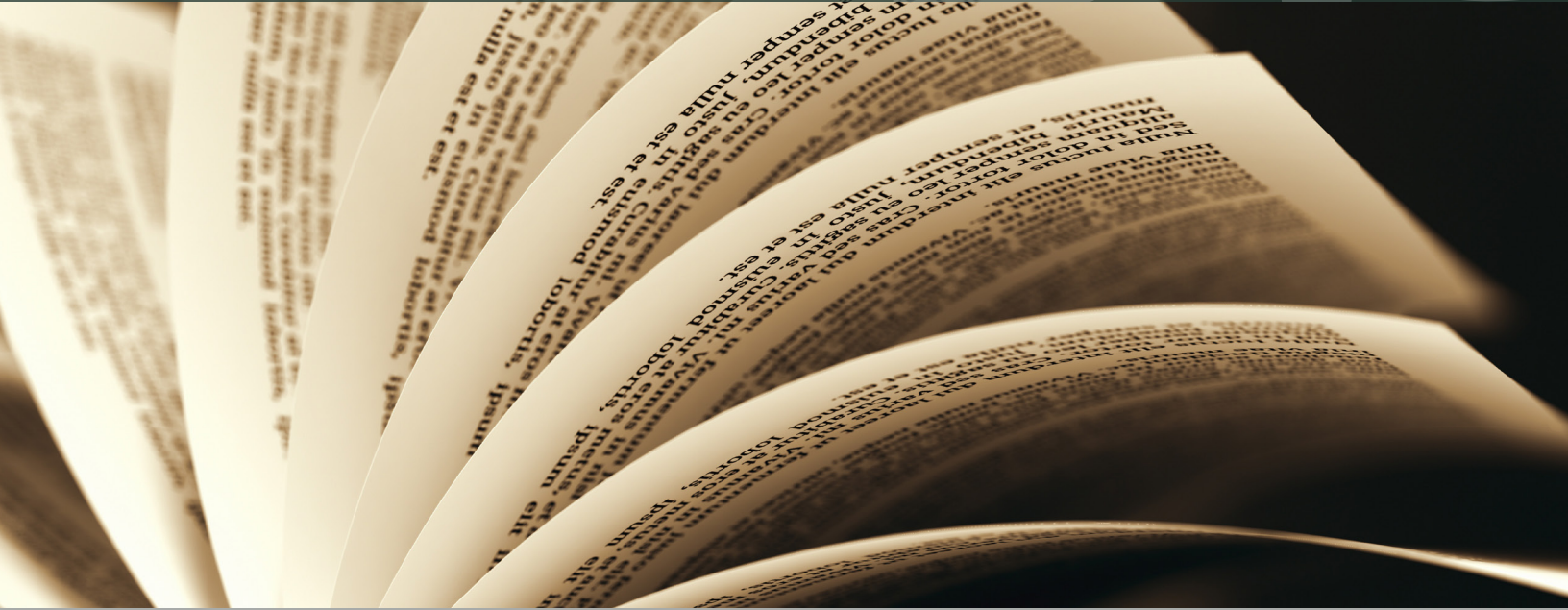


ENGLISH
